Lacombe County makes final contribution to Lacombe Memorial Centre

(Lacombe, Alberta) – At the March 8 Lacombe County Council meeting, Council directed an additional \$250,000 contribution to the Lacombe Memorial Centre (LMC), bringing Lacombe County's total contribution to the project to \$750,000.

At the meeting, Town of Lacombe representatives requested and received Council's approval to name a room in the facility in recognition of Lacombe County.

"I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the Town of Lacombe and the LMC organizing committee for their efforts on a very successful project," said Lacombe County Reeve Terry Engen. "We are also appreciative of the Town for providing us with the opportunity to have a room in the LMC named in recognition of Lacombe County."

"There is a great need for this type of facility, not just in Lacombe, but in the community as a whole," added Terry Hager, Lacombe County Commissioner. "We are confident that the LMC will be utilized by many County residents and businesses, making it a true community centre."

The LMC is expected to be operational this summer, with a grand opening scheduled for early fall.
