I am providing the following written submissions that I would request be added to 6.3, Policies of Stormwater Management of Bylaw 1310/19:

6.3.5 Lacombe Lake shall remain free of storm water, preserving it for future generations of Albertans, and residents of Lacombe County, for the recreational activities of swimming, paddle boarding and boating, as it is now used.

6.3.6 Lacombe Lake shall remain free of storm water, protecting the stable water level needed for the 12 bird species who nest directly on the surface water of Lacombe Lake, so that nest destruction by storm water surges could not occur.

6.3.7 Lacombe Lake shall remain free of storm water, protecting the water quality and survivability of the fish for the numerous identified species of large birds,

sometimes arriving hundreds at a time, who stop to feed at Lacombe Lake for several days on their spring northward migration to their nesting sites, and again on their return journeys in the fall.
