

BYLAW NO. 1360/22

A BYLAW OF LACOMBE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO REPEAL BYLAW NO 1062/07, A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE LACOMBE COUNTY TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTION TO ESTABLISH THE SYVLAN LAKE REGIONAL WASTEWATER COMMISSION.

WHEREAS under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c.M-26-1, as amended, the Council of Lacombe County has been granted the authority to pass, revise and repeals bylaws for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS Lacombe County adopted Bylaw 1062/07, a Bylaw to authorize Lacombe County to take the necessary action to establish the Sylvan Lake Regional Wastewater Commission; and

WHEREAS on August 26, 2021 Lacombe County Council approved a resolution supporting the merging of the Sylvan Lake Regional Water and Wastewater Commission to be known as the Sylvan Lake Regional Water/Wastewater Commission;

WHEREAS section 602.02 of the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000, c.M-26-1, as amended, only require a resolution of Council to participate in the establishment of a commission;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Lacombe County duly assembled in the Province of Alberta enacts as follows:

1. That Lacombe County Bylaw No. 1062/07 be hereby repealed.
2. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon final passage thereof.
