

BYLAW NO. 1214/15

A BYLAW OF LACOMBE COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND THE LACOMBE COUNTY LAND USE BYLAW NO. 1056/07, PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, BEING CHAPTER M-26-1 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED

THE COUNCIL of Lacombe County, duly assembled, enacts that Bylaw No. 1056/07 be amended as follows:

approximately 2.57 hectares (6.368 acres) of land legally described as:

Meridian 5 range 2 township 39

Section 21

Quarter north west

All that portion described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the west boundary of said

Quarter section, distant southerly five hundred and twenty eight and one

Half (528 ½) feet, from the north west corner thereof, thence southerly

Along said western boundary five hundred and seventy (570) feet, more or less

To the waters of Snake Lake, as shown on a plan of survey of the said

Township dated on the 3rd day of September A.D. 1902, thence north

Westerly following the western boundary of the said lake to a point due

East from the point of commencement, thence westerly a distance of four hundred and ten (410) feet, more or less, to the point of commencement

Containing 2.43 hectares 96 acres) more or less.

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

as outlined in red on Schedule 'A' attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw

from Recreational "P-R" to Agricultural "A".
