

BYLAW NO. 1022/06

A BYLAW OF LACOMBE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE LACOMBE COUNTY TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTION TO ESTABLISH A REGIONAL WATER SERVICES COMMISSION.

WHEREAS Lacombe County wishes to participate in the establishment of a regional water services commission pursuant to Part 15.1 of the *Municipal Government Act* (R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 as amended);

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the power conferred upon it by the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of [insert municipality's name], duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SECTION 1

SHORT TITLE

- 1.1 This Bylaw shall be known and may be cited as the "Regional Water Services Commission Authorization Bylaw" of Lacombe County.

SECTION 2

REGIONAL WATER SERVICES COMMISSION

- 2.1 The Council of Lacombe County is hereby authorized to make any necessary Agreements and take the necessary action together with the Council of any other Municipality or Municipalities for the establishment of a regional water services commission pursuant to Part 15.1 of the *Municipal Government Act*.

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon final passage thereof.
