Lacombe County is accepting applications for **Summer General Labourers** to work with maintenance and/or construction crew members in our Operations department, performing a variety of manual and physical tasks throughout Lacombe County. **The approximate term date for this 4 month position is May 1, 2023 - August 31, 2023.**

Key Responsibilities

Technical

- Perform a variety of general labour tasks at various parks, beaches and green spaces.
- Operate basic hand and power tools including hand mowers, power mowers, tractor mowers, compactors, skid steers, tractors, etc.
- Perform a variety of landscaping and clean-up activities as directed.
- Assist with the maintenance and construction of roads, pavements, trails, road clearing, site clean-up, and traffic control functions.
- Interact with the public in a respectful and professional manner.
- Participate in workplace safety initiatives and meetings as required. Report to work fit for duty.

Key Qualifications

- Have experience (and enjoy) working outdoors in various weather conditions and be able to perform medium lifting and moving of objects up to 40lbs.
- Preference will be given to candidates with a working knowledge of small equipment (mowers, weed eaters, tractors, etc.) and to those with related labour experience.
- Possess and be able to maintain a valid Class 5 Alberta Driver's License (current abstract required upon hire).
- Must have a proven ability to interact with others in a calm, courteous and respectful manner.
- Able to understand and execute oral and written instruction.
- This position is considered a safety/ sensitive position. The successful applicant will need to participate in the Pre-Employment Drug and Alcohol Testing.

The wage for this position starts at \$23.06/hr (includes stat and vacation pay) for the first 8hrs and \$31.11/hr for overtime hours.
