

BYLAW NO. 1266/18

A BYLAW OF LACOMBE COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND THE LACOMBE COUNTY LAND USE BYLAW NO. 1237/17, PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, BEING CHAPTER M-26-1 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS notice was given of Council's intention to amend the Land Use Bylaw in the following local newspapers:

THE COUNCIL of Lacombe County, duly assembled, enacts that Bylaw No. 1237/17 be amended as follows:

Approximately 64 hectares (160 acres) of land legally described as:

THE SOUTH WEST QUARTER OF SECTION SEVEN (7)  
TOWNSHIP FORTY ONE (41)  
RANGE TWENTY SIX (26)  
WEST OF THE FOURTH MERIDIAN,  
CONTAINING 64.7 HECTARES (160 ACRES) MORE OR LESS.  
EXCEPTING THEREOUT: HECTARES (ACRES) MORE OR LESS  
A) PLAN 3973TR - ROAD 0.417 1.03  
EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

as outlined in red on the attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw

from Agricultural "A" District to Recreation "PR" District.
