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Policy Title <b>GRAVEL PROGRAM</b>	Date: <b>February 23, 2023</b>	Resolution No. <b>C/84/23</b>

**Policy Statement**

All gravel roads are to be regravelled from time to time as necessary to provide a road that is generally passable for traffic under normal weather conditions.

Regravelling is to be undertaken each year based on priorities established within the limits of the annual operating budget. Priorities are to be determined with consideration to the road classification and the existing gravel condition of the road relative to the amount and type of traffic.

**Regulation**

**1. Gravel Crushing**

The County Manager or designate shall prepare estimates of gravel crushing requirements for the following year. The estimates shall provide detail on the quantities required for regravelling, gravelling or new construction, gravel for asphalt projects, gravel sales, and any gravel for reserve.

**2. Gravelling**

- 1) The County Manager or designate shall determine the roads to be regravelled.
- 2) Generally 1/3rd of the gravel roads will have an application each year.
- 3) The County Manager or designate will administer the program, have all gravel applications recorded, and generate the appropriate (proposed and final) maps and reports.
- 4) The gravel checker shall ensure that signs warning the public of loose gravel are placed on the stretch of road that is being gravelled.
- 5) Dust control will be provided to affected ratepayers along the haul route at the County's cost.
- 6) The district grader operator shall maintain the newly graveled road as soon as possible but no later than 14 hours from the time of application.
- 7) Any gravelling expenditure to exceed budget allocations or use of reserve gravel requires the approval of the County Manager.
