Policy Statement

The County may undertake work with County-owned equipment and resources at the request of an urban municipality within the County.

Regulation

- 1. Requested work in the urban municipality is an extension of work being undertaken in the County. Special trips or priority would not be provided.
- 2. Work undertaken would be deemed minor in nature and as a cooperative action between two municipalities. The County does not wish to compete with the private sector offering similar services.
- 3. Work undertaken would not unduly interfere or delay work to be performed in the County.
- Work undertaken is to be charged at cost plus 15% percent. The County Manager or designate may determine the method of charges and invoicing procedures.
 (i.e. per occurrence, semi-annual, annual, average annual, etc.)
- 5. The County accepts no responsibility for any actions or claims for damages resulting from the performance or non-performance of work.
- 6. The requesting municipality shall notify the County Manager or his designate, in writing, outlining the intended work to be performed by the County.
- 7. The County Manager or designate may, subject to the preceding criteria, approve requests from urban municipalities for maintenance work.
- 8. If approved, the urban municipality is to enter into an agreement with the County for the said work.
