## **Policy Statement:**

Fire Guardians are appointed by the County pursuant to the provisions of the *Forest and Prairie Protection Act* and the Lacombe County Chief Administrative Officer Bylaw No. 1246/17. Fire Permits are generally required from March 1 to October 31, but may change according to the Provincial Fire Permit Season as required.

## **Guidelines/Procedures:**

## Fire Guardian Duties:

- 1. Issue fire permits to applicants when in the opinion of the Guardian the burning proposed by the applicant may be properly controlled.
- 2. May carry out inspections of fires to determine if they are in compliance with conditions set out in the fire permit, bylaw or regulation.
- 3. May order a fire extinguished for contraventions of the permit, bylaw or regulation.
- 4. May call for the local Fire Department to extinguish a fire if required.
