To change the zoning of approximately 4.04 hectares (10 acres) of land legally described as:

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

Area: 28.66 hectares (70.82 acres) more or less

as outlined in dashed white on Schedule 'A' attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw from Agricultural "A" District to Heavy Industrial "I-HI" District.
