

BYLAW NO.1456/26

A BYLAW OF LACOMBE COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO RESCIND BYLAW 1309/19, THE PONOKA COUNTY/LACOMBE COUNTY INTERMUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN (the "IDP")

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended (the "Act"), allows a municipality to repeal or amend a bylaw;

AND WHEREAS Section 631(2) of the Act exempts bordering municipalities from the requirement of Section 631(1) to adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan should the Councils of each municipality agree that an Intermunicipal Development Plan is not required;

AND WHEREAS the Councils of both municipalities deem it appropriate to rescind the IDP;

AND WHEREAS notice was given of Lacombe County Council's intention to rescind the IDP in the following local newspapers:

Lacombe County News	March 20, 2026
Ponoka News	March 25 and April 1, 2026

AND WHEREAS Lacombe County held a public hearing on April 9, 2026, to allow the general public to comment on the proposed rescindment of the IDP;

NOW THEREFORE Lacombe County Council duly assembled, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, as amended, hereby enacts as follows:


1. Bylaw 1309/19 is hereby rescinded.
2. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on the third and final reading hereof, and signature by the Reeve and County Manager.

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon final passage thereof.
